Historical: While non-members, Ann said: One night – it was midnight – as my husband and I, in our house at Kirtland, were praying to the father to be shown the way, the spirit rested upon us and a cloud overshadowed the house...We saw the cloud and we felt the spirit of the Lord. Then we heard a voice out of the cloud saying: "Prepare to receive the word o the Lord, for it is coming!" At this we marveled greatly; but from that moment we knew that the word of the Lord was coming to Kirtland (WM 41-42). They were baptized in November, 1830. Joseph and Emma arrived in Feb/1831. Joseph jumped from the wagon, entered the store, taking the proprietor by the hand, "Newel K. Whitney, thou art the man! I am Joseph the Prophet; you have prayed me here, now what do you want of me?"

In this home, Joseph Smith healed the disabled rheumatoid arm of Alice Johnson: "Here is Mrs. Johnson with a lame arm; has God given any power to man now on the earth to cure her?" On his way out of the room he paused, taking her by the hand and declaring: "...in a solemn and impressive manner, 'Woman, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ I command the to be whole.'" She was immediately healed, resulting in the conversion of several present.

Revelation: The Father and the Son appeared in the room of School of the Prophets. "Joseph asked if we saw him. I saw him and suppose that others did and Joseph answered

that is Jesus, the Son of God, our elder brother. Afterward, Joseph told us to resume our former position in prayer, which we did. Another person came through; he was surrounded as with a flame of fire...The Prophet Joseph said this was the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. I saw Him" (John Murdoch, ENS Jan. 1993, PJE. 111)

Spiritual outpourings and speaking in tongues.

Room for School of Prophets: built at Joseph Smith's request. School began Jan. 22, 1833. He used it for translating and as the administrative headquarters of the Church. Completed one phase of JST here in 1833. School for the elders - 1834. Lectures on Faith - 1835, taught by Sidney Rigdon and Joseph. Hebrew lessons - 1836.
