Location: Fayette, NY

Hours: Mon – Sat 10-5; Sun 1-5

Driving directions: From Palmyra, Vienna Rd, Co Hwy 27/Co Rd 27 and McBurney Rd to NY-96 S in Phelps (12.0 mi). NY-96 S to Fayette (15.2 mi). Aunkst Rd to destination.

Closest Temple: Palmyra, NY

Time Needed Here: Up to 2 hours

Next Stop: SE: Susquehanna, PA (111 mi)

SW: Kirtland, OH (277 mi)

NW: Palmyra, NY (32 mi)

W: Niagara Falls (126 mi)



Church Ownership: 100 acres

Historical: 1980 a session of General Conference was broadcast from here in reconstructed double log home.

Church History: Field mysteriously plowed by 3 men, as David needed in Palmyra.. Beginning June of 1829, Joseph and Oliver moved in with large (9) Whitmer family to finish translating Book of Mormon (about 30 days.) 6 Whitmers called as witnesses to gold plates, and Mary Whitmer shown them by Moroni. 2 of them were probably scribes. The Church organized with 6 members April 6, 1830, 50 people attending. Joseph/Oliver ordained each other as 1st elders. Many ordained to priesthood offices. Whitmers moved to Kirtland in May 1831.
